Applications can be forwarded to your school Scholarship Committee or Career Centre/Counseling Dept., by April 28, 2023 and clearly designated as "MRTA Greta Hare/Paul Bondar Application"

The applications will then be forwarded to the MRTA office for the final consideration/selection process.
